We are excited to announce that **Punta Cana Surf Adventure** is getting ready to re-open!

Our number one priority has always been the safety of our guests and staff.

Consequently, we are adhering to the guidelines of the Dominican Ministry of Public Health, and the Ministry of Tourism by adding new protocols to our operation to provide a safe environment for everyone.

In relation to our activity, scientists have reported that the presence of salt, added to the virus load getting significantly diluted in the ocean, make a hostile environment unlikely conducive for transmission of viruses.

Also, factors like high temperatures, direct sunlight (UV rays) and high humidity can decrease the viability of viruses.

# Protocols

## General Guidelines

If a booked guest has been sick within the 14 days prior to his/her activity, has come into contact with a Covid-19 confirmed person, or has suffered Covid-19 like symptoms, we ask that he/she does not attend the activity. We will offer a credit, reschedule or issue a full refund.

# Pick-up and Drop Off

- The use of a face mask is mandatory in the bus. Clients should bring their own. We will have masks available for clients if needed.
- Our bus will be disinfected before and after each pick up service.
- Following the guidelines of the Dominican health authorities transportation will be reduced to a 50% capacity.
- Guests will have their temperature taken before boarding the bus. If the corporal temperature is above 38.5C (100F). The guest will not be allowed boarding and the lessons will be canceled and a full refund issued.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided before boarding the bus.
- Clients will seat at assigned seats inside the bus, indicated by the driver.



# At The Surf School

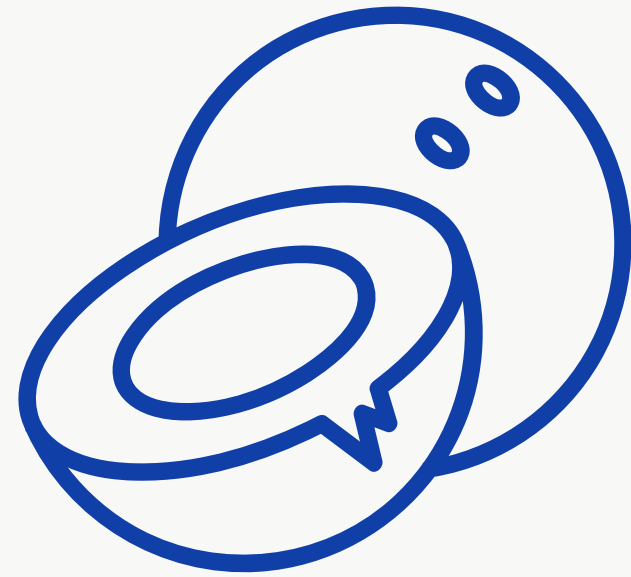
- Our lockers will be disinfected regularly upon arrival and departure of students.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the school for use of students.
- Students will be encouraged to maintain social distancing standards.
- While providing theory and practical lesson in the sand, students and instructors will be wearing masks and maintaining social distancing.
- The “practice boards” on the sand will be sanitized before and after each lesson.
- Rash-guards are taken off property for proper cleaning and sanitation daily. Guests will receive a sanitized rashguard if they do not bring their own.



# In-Water Lesson/Practice

- Instructors will be assigned to groups, couples or individuals that are part of the same party.
- Equipment will be sanitized before and after each lesson.
- Masks can not be worn in the water; therefore, we will enforce social distancing between instructors/students as much as possible.
- Instructors will try to communicate non-verbally as much as possible. Using signals that will be previously explained.

# Fruit / Water



- Fruit will be provided at the end of the lesson (not the break), when the surfers are back at the school and hands can be properly sanitized.
- Sanitized water bottles will be provided during the break.

# Staff



- Staff's temperature will be measured daily before starting to work. And will be asked to remain isolated if they have come into contact with any Covid-19 confirmed person.
- Our photographer will be wearing facemask and socially distancing at the time of showing pictures to the clients.
